


Figure 1 - 2: Industry Shares and Growth




Figure 2 - 3: Health Care & Soc. Asst.




Figure 2 - 4: Accom. & Food Srvcs






Figure 2 - 5: Retail Trade




Figure 2 - 6: Trans. & Ware.





Figure 2 - 7: Educ. Services
